

BANKS TOWNSHIP BOARD RESOLUTION #2 of 2025
REQUEST FOR TREE AND LIMB REMOVAL ALONG OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY

WHEREAS, the Banks Township Board recognizes the importance of maintaining safe and navigable roadways within the township for the safety and convenience of residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, numerous old trees and overhanging limbs along Old Dixie Highway present potential hazards to motorists, pedestrians, and adjacent properties, particularly in adverse weather conditions; and

WHEREAS, the presence of aged and deteriorating trees poses a risk of falling limbs, which could lead to downed power lines, road obstruction, property damage, and injury; and

WHEREAS, regular maintenance and proactive removal of such trees and limbs will enhance public safety, improve road visibility, and ensure the long-term sustainability of the roadway infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Antrim County Road Commission is responsible for overseeing the road maintenance and ensuring the safety of roadways within Antrim County, including Old Dixie Highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Banks Township Board formally requests the Antrim County Road Commission to assess and take necessary actions to remove old trees and hazardous limbs along Old Dixie Highway within the jurisdiction of Banks Township; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Antrim County Road Commission for consideration and action at the earliest feasible opportunity.
