Discussion on Recreational Vehicle Ordinance language: The Township Board feels the issue could be regulated with different criteria, i.e., blight ordinance, campground language.

MMSC by Nancy, Marion, that the licensing from the state be added to the Zoning Ordinance. No permit shall be required for the location of a recreational vehicle which has a current license from the state.

Mary will prepare the official language for the amendment. We will accept Mary's recommendation on repealing Section 4.02 and 4.09.6

We will hold a Public Hearing in September to consider the amendments we have been holding.
